Deanery Synod Vacancies, there are two vacancies for Deanery Synod Representatives. These members sit on the Haringey Deanery Synod representing Holy Trinity Church, and report back to the PCC. Meetings are 3-4 times a year and cover matters of concern within the Diocese. They also vote for the members of the General Synod of the Church of England who have a voice in shaping our church nationally. The next meeting of Deanery Synod will be held at Holy Trinity on Wednesday 7th October from 7pm.
